

Notification of 3 Year Asbestos Re-inspections

In compliance with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), in August of 1988 we performed inspections of each of our buildings for asbestos-containing building materials. The inspection findings and asbestos management plans have been on file in the school administrative office since that time.

The EPA requires us to perform re-inspections of the asbestos materials every three years. Environmental Hazard Control, Inc. has completed the three-year AHERA re-inspection for Wyandotte Public Schools, or LEA #0604. The Re-inspection was conducted on July 5, 2012 by Oklahoma Department of Labor Licensed Asbestos Management Planner Dean Swain # OKMP134900. An accredited management planner reviewed the results of the re-inspections and recommended actions we should take to safely manage each asbestos material our buildings.

All asbestos materials in this school are in good condition and we will continue to manage them in place, as recommended by the accredited management planner.

The results of the re-inspection are on file in the management plan in the school's administrative office. Everyone is welcome to view these anytime during normal school hours.
