The purpose of providing Internet and other computer network access in this district is to promote the exchange of information and ideas with the global community. The following represents a guide to the acceptable use of the technology provided by this district. All network use must be consistent with the policies and goals of this school. Inappropriate use of this technology will result in the loss of technology use, disciplinary action, and/or referral to legal authorities.

All internet and computer network users will be expected to abide by the generally accepted rules of network etiquette. These include, but are not limited to:

1. Be polite. Message should not be abusive to others.
2. Take pride in communications. Check spelling and grammar.
3. Use appropriate language. Do not swear or use vulgarities or any inappropriate language, symbols, or pictures.
4. Protect password confidentiality. Passwords are not to be shared with others. Using another person's account or password or allowing such access by another may be permitted only with the approval of the supervising teacher or system administrator.
5. Do not reveal your personal address or telephone number or those of others. No student information protected by FERPA should be electronically transmitted or otherwise disseminated through the network.
6. Do not disguise the point of origin or transmission of electronic mail.
7. Do not send messages that contain false, malicious, or misleading information which may be injurious to another person.
8. Illegal activities are strictly prohibited.
9. The district technology is not to be used for playing multiuser or other network intensive games, commercial ventures, internet relay chat lines, or downloading excessively large files.
10. Do not use "non-educational" chat rooms, social networking websites, blogs, and instant messaging services at school on district hardware.
11. No charges for services, products, or information are to be incurred without appropriate permission.
12. Do not use the network in such a way that you would disrupt the use of the network by other users.
13. Users shall respect the privacy of others and not read mail or files of others without permission. Copyright and licensing laws will not be intentionally violated.
14. Vandalism will result in cancellation of privileges. Vandalism is defined as any malicious attempt to harm or destroy hardware, data of another user, Internet or any other agencies or other networks which might be accessed. This includes but is not limited to, the uploading or creation of computer viruses, malware, or spyware.
15. Do not use mobile communication devices or other technologies to engage in cyber-bullying at school or disrupt the instructional process.
16. Report security problems to the supervising teacher or system administrator.
17. Violators of this policy shall hold the district, including its employees and agents, harmless against and all causes of action, damages, or other liabilities resulting from the willful or negligent violation of this policy.

Every student, regardless of age, must read and sign below.

I have read, understand, and agree to abide by the terms of the foregoing Code of Conduct Internet and Other Computer Network Access Policy. Should I commit any violation or in any way misuse my access to the school district's computer network and the Internet, I understand and agree that my access privilege may be revoked and school disciplinary action may be taken against me.

Further, I accept full responsibility for the supervision of my child's/ward's use of his/her access account if and when such access is not in the school setting. I hereby give permission for my child/ward to use the building approved account to access the school district's computer network and the Internet.
